1. Camp Registration opens on March 25<sup>th</sup>, at 6pm. Upon arrival the player or the parent must provide player's Birth Certificate and a Picture ID or Passport. **If any player is not born in 2009, they will not be allowed to participate.**



2. It is parent/athlete responsibility to ensure that the child attends scheduled practices, training, games consistently, on time, and in a disciplined manner.
3. It is parent/athlete responsibility to notify PAYFA personnel at least 2 hours before the scheduled session or practice AND at least 24 hours before an official contest/competition/match of the child's absence or potential tardiness.
4. All registering with PAYFA agree to show respect for other members, coaches, opponents, parents, and other officials present during games and or practices.
5. No offensive/aggressive behavior towards any member, parent, or other party accompanying a child during games or practices will be tolerated.
6. PAYFA owns full and complete ownership of all photo/video footage produced during practices and scrimmages.
